HVAC Maintenance Checklist

- 1. Inspect and replace air filters every 1-3 months.
- 2. Check and clean vents and registers to ensure proper airflow.
- 3. Inspect ductwork for leaks or blockages and seal as needed.
- 4. Clean the outdoor condenser unit by removing debris and washing fins.
- 5. Check thermostat settings and recalibrate if necessary.
- 6. Test system performance by running it through a full cycle.
- 7. Inspect and clean blower motor and fan blades. 8. Verify refrigerant levels and check for leaks.
- 9. Examine electrical connections and tighten loose components.
- 10. Schedule professional HVAC servicing at least once a year.
- 11. Ensure proper insulation around ducts and windows.
- 12. Keep the area around outdoor units clear of plants and obstructions.
- 13. Monitor energy bills for sudden spikes, which may indicate issues. 14. Check for unusual noises or smells during operation.
- 15. Replace batteries in your thermostat annually.
